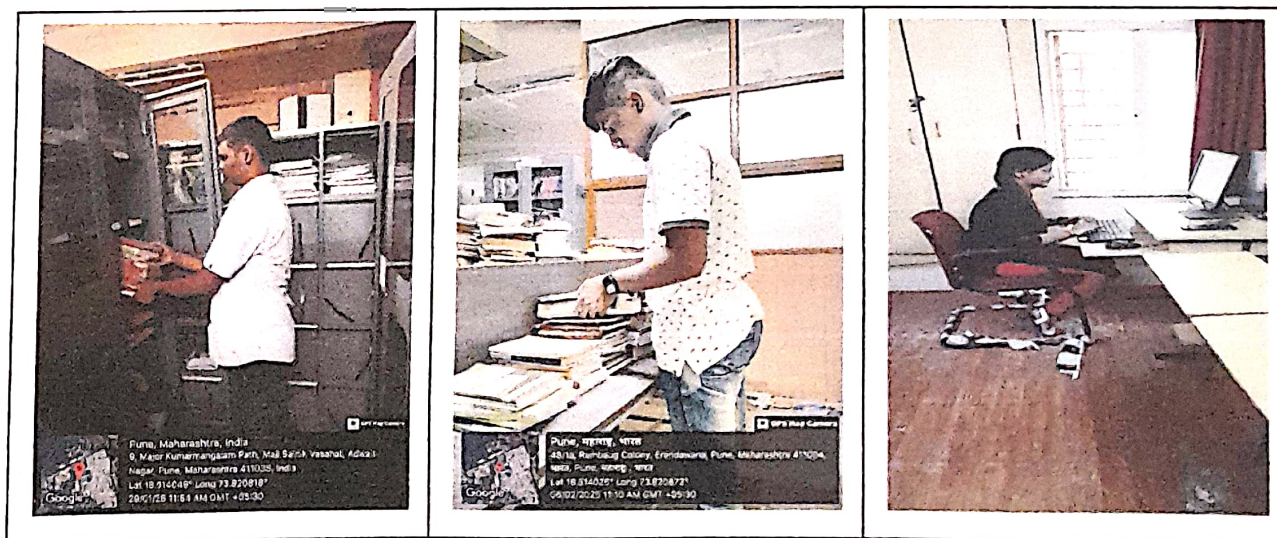
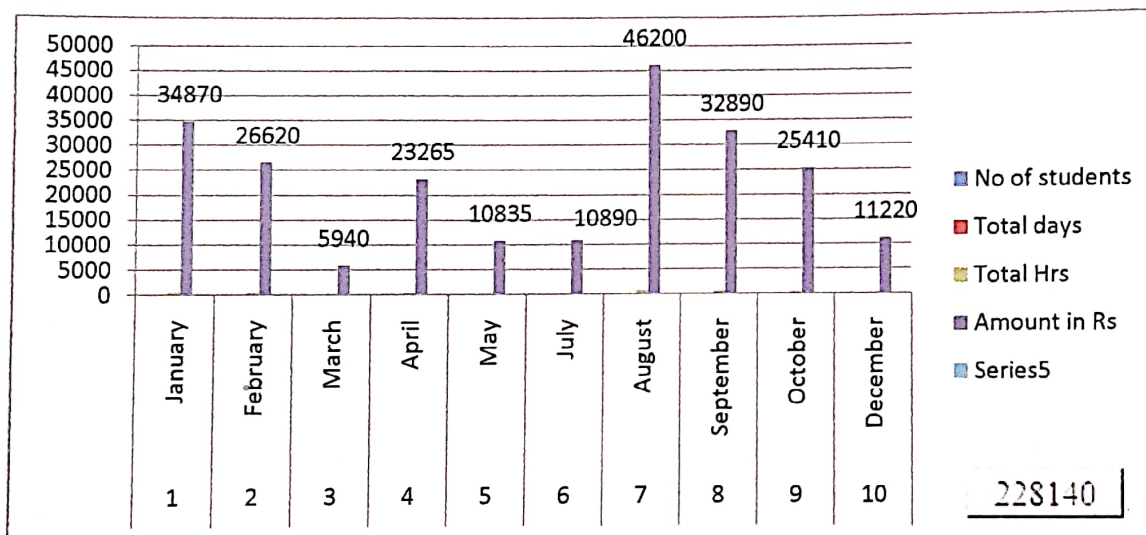

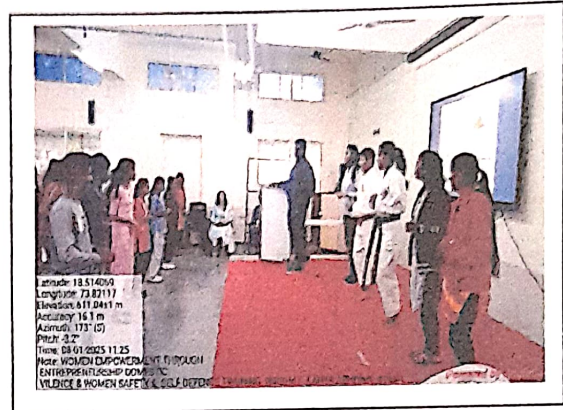
Earn and Learn Scheme:

The Earn and Learn scheme was implemented in the college in association of SPPU Pune . The details of the scheme from March 2024 to February 2025 are as follows. The university provides 90% funding and college bears 10% amount.



Nirbhaya Kanya Abhiyan :

Nirbhaya Kanya Abhiyan was organized at in association with Student SPPU on 8th January 2025. SPPU sanctioned Rs 5000/- funds for activity. A total of 105 students from arts commerce and science faculty participated in this workshop. A workshop on literary writing and presentation was conducted from 30th January 2025 to 31st January 2025 . Dr. Uma Kulkarni, a senior translator and recipient of the Sahitya Akademi Award, provided guidance on literary writing. Shri Girish Korvi, a poet and screenplay writer, guided on the presentation of literature. Shri Vighnesh Joshi, a script and dialogue writer as well as a lyricist, provided insights on literary presentation .Prof. Archana Patil from MMC Pune conducted a session on storytelling skills. Total 97 students and 9 teachers participated in the workshop. SPPU provided (sanctioned) fund of Amount Rs 8000/- .

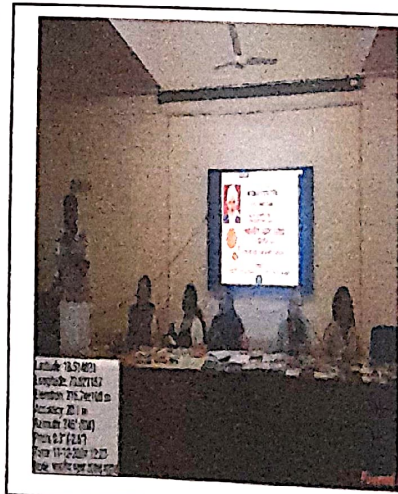
Anti-Ragging Week:

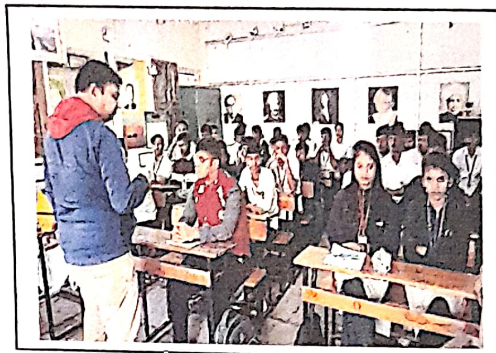
Bhartiya Bhasha Utsav:

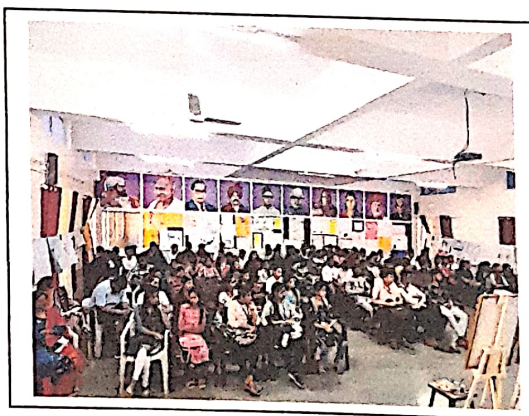
Sound pollution awareness workshop:

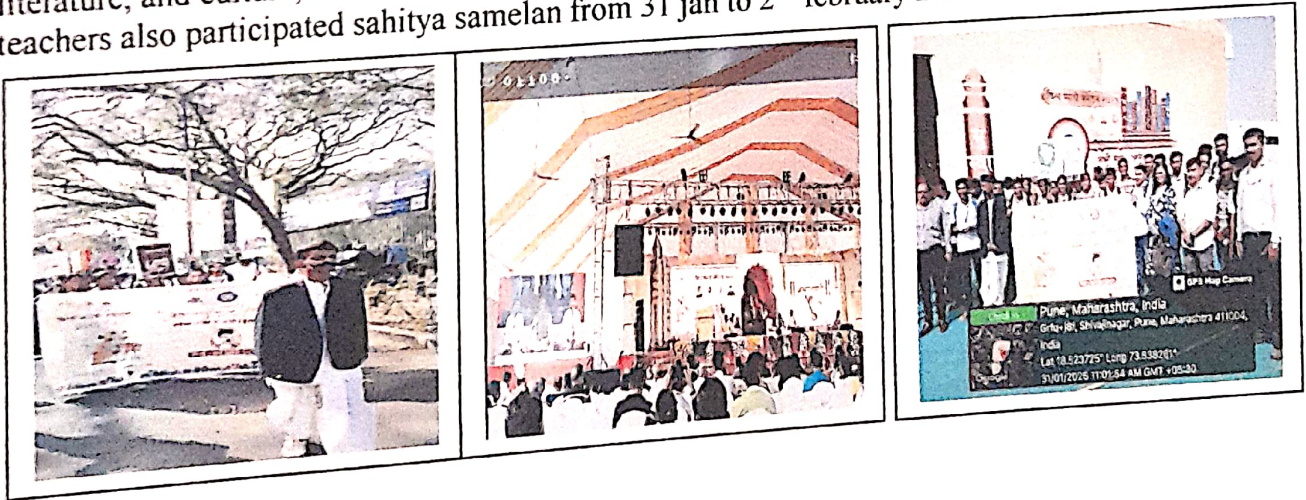

Bharat Pada Yatra :

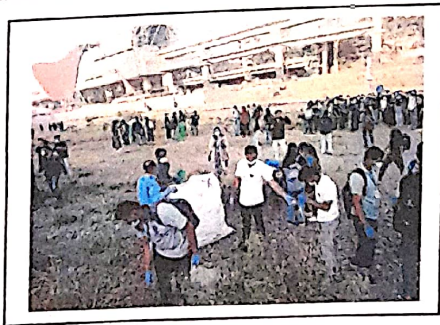

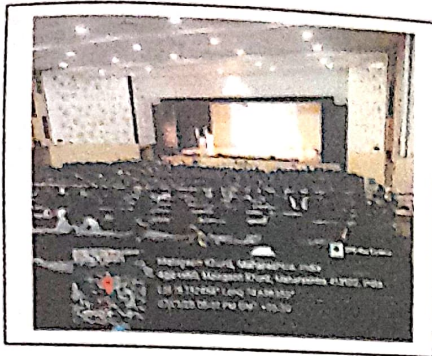


Student Participation:

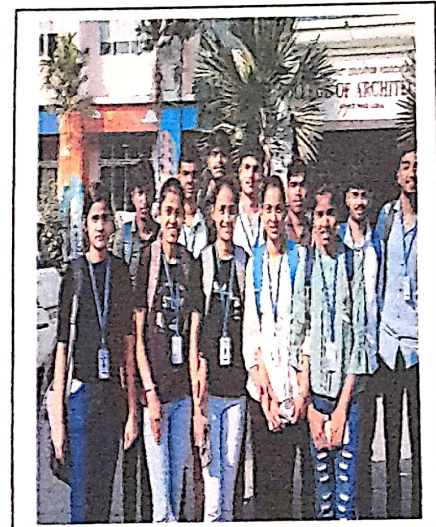
group of 20 students for group discussion. All students participated actively throughout the program.

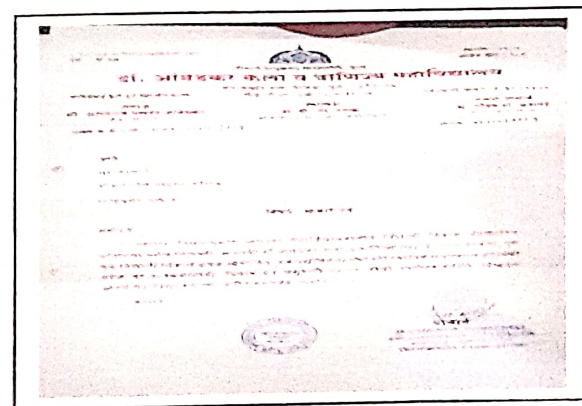
